Policy: Individual Membership



Individuals who are not members of OSHA may apply for and be granted an Individual Membership to allow the athlete or management (coach, trainer, manager) to participate in the Ontario ParaSport Winter Games (OPWG) as well as other OSHA programs.

To qualify for an Individual Membership the athlete/management applicant:

1. Must come from outside an area serviced by an OSHA member club.
2. Must carry or get Hockey Canada sanctioned insurance coverage.
3. Pay an annual 'non-refundable' individual Membership fee (\$25/athlete or \$15/management) for each season.
4. To compete in the OPWG, the athlete must:
 - Have an approved Individual Membership
 - Meet the qualifications criteria for the event as defined by ParaSport Ontario and OSHA.
 - Attend the Player Talent Identification Camps (TIC) and a minimum of 50% of the exhibition games, as scheduled by OSHA organizing committee.
5. To participate in other OSHA programs, the athlete/manager must meet the requirements as specified for that program.
