Examples:

- A player wishing to play at the **Junior/Novice level**, who requires the use of a SHEO sledge, would pay a total of **\$355.00** (\$275 + \$30 + \$50), and a second family member wishing to play at the junior level with a SHEO sledge would pay **\$305.00** (\$225 + \$30+ \$50) – amounting to a family total cost of **\$660.00, plus \$30 insurance** for a Parent/ Pushers going on ice, if applicable.
- A player wishing to play at the **Intermediate level**, who does not require the use of a SHEO sledge, would pay a total of **\$305.00** (\$275 + \$30), and a second family member wishing to play at the Junior level would pay **\$255.00** (\$225 + \$30) – amounting to a family total cost of **\$560.00, plus \$30 insurance** for a Parent/ Pushers going on ice, if applicable.
- A player wishing to play **Intermediate and House League** would pay **\$580.00** (\$550 + \$30), and a second family member wishing to play intermediate and house league would pay a total of **\$530.00** (\$30 + \$500) – amounting to a family total cost of **\$1,110.00**.

2010-2011 REGISTRATION RULES AND PROCEDURES

The Sledge Hockey of Eastern Ontario Association welcomes all new and returning players, to our next season! Before proceeding with registrations, please take a moment to review the following Registration Procedures and Rules carefully.

- 1) The Registration form – with full payment – must be completed, signed and given to SHEO team managers (Laura, Gordon or Angelo), prior to players being permitted to enter the ice the first time.
- 2) Mandatory protective equipment must be worn on the ice at all times, see list at <http://www.sheo.ca>
- 3) Persons who just want to try sledge will be permitted on the ice one time, after they have completed and signed a registration form and paid for insurance coverage (\$30.00).
- 4) Receipts will be provided upon request. Note that fees paid could be eligible for income tax purposes under the Children's fitness amount (Line 365 in 2009) if your child meets the age criteria: under the age of 16 at the beginning of the year and for children with disabilities under the age of 18.
- 5) An NSF fee of \$25 will be charged on all returned cheques in additional to any bank fees charged to SHEO
- 6) No partial refunds will be issued after December 31, 2010.
- 7) Registered and active coaching staff is automatically insured by ODHA at no charge. Further, if someone is already registered in a Hockey Canada activity (regular adult league, Team Canada, etc), they do not need to be insured to play sledge hockey or to go on ice - but we need to know which activity people are already insured for to provide to ODHA.
- 8) Please make cheque payable to SHEO (Sledge Hockey of Eastern Ontario).

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- Initial Registrations will take place at the Jim Durrell Arena on: September 24, 05:30 pm – 08:30 pm or September 26, 10:30 pm – 03:30 pm
- Annual General Meeting will take place at the at Jim Durrell Arena on: Sunday, October 17, 01:00 pm – 02:00pm

WHAT IS SLEDGE HOCKEY?

Sledge Hockey is a team sport that disabled and non-disabled participants can play on an equal basis. Sledge hockey conforms to the rules and form of traditional hockey. The skills required to control and propel the sledge adds a new element of excitement and challenge to a game already well known for its fast pace and outstanding team work.

Sledge Hockey is an innovative team sport that incorporates the same rules and discipline structure as regular ice hockey. Sledge hockey players sit on specially designed sleds, or 'sledges', with skate blades under the seat. Two sticks are used to not only pass, stickhandle and shoot the puck, but also to propel and manoeuvre their sledges. Canada is a recognized world leader in the development of the sport of sledge hockey and equipment for players. Athletes wear the same hockey equipment as authorized by the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association.

SLEDGE HOCKEY OF EASTERN ONTARIO (SHEO)

Sledge Hockey of Eastern Ontario is an association made up of handicapped athletes, their families, coaches and volunteers who take part in a wonderful sport called sledge hockey (also named "sled hockey" by our friend from the USA). The association has a long history dating back about 30 years. Initially, the Ottawa-Carleton Sledge Hockey and Ice Picking Association (OCSHIP) organised the sport in the region when ice picking races were held out of doors. Eventually, playing sledge hockey became the predominant sport given the interest and the increased availability of arenas.

Quick Facts:

- Established as OCSHIP in 1982
- Issued letters patent as Ontario Corporation Number 855897 on April 5, 1990
- A member of the Ottawa District Hockey Association (ODHA) Branch of Hockey Canada in 2004
- Associate member of the National Capital Sports Council for the Disabled (NCSCD)
- Players are from Ottawa and the surrounding area including: Almonte, Beachburg, Bourget, Casselman, Cornwall, Gatineau, Lunenburg, Morewood, Rockland, Thurso, and Winchester
- Current roster of about 50 to 80 players in three divisions
- Season normally runs from September to April each year
- Regular games and practices usually take place at the Jim Durrell Arena

- A player wishing to play at the Intermediate and House League levels, and also play on the OSHA League Senior Competitive Team would pay a total of **\$760.00** (\$550.00 + \$30 +180). A second family member wishing to play at the Intermediate level and House League would pay a total of **\$530.00** (\$500.00 + \$30). The family total cost will be at minimum **\$1,290** (\$760.00 + \$530.00), plus sledge rental and parent/pusher insurance fees – if applicable.
